

Board Game Extravaganza Project

Guidelines:

You will create a board game that covers all topics discussed in Biology, World Geography, and English this fall semester. The format for the game is your choice. Each game must include the following:

- 25 questions and answers for Biology, 25 questions and answers for World Geography, and 25 questions and answers for English. (total of 75 questions) – They must be numbered and in this order when turned in. The question must also be labeled as level one, two, or three.
 - 15 level one questions (on the line)
 - 5 level two questions (between the lines)
 - 5 level three questions (beyond the line)
- The questions must be unique and not identical to any old test or dialectical journal questions.
- All questions and answers must be **typed**.
- Include typed rules for playing the game.
- Include all necessary accessories: board, cards, dice, game pieces, etc.

The final project is due **Monday, December 15th at 8am** in Miss Bullis's room.

- You must turn in a hard copy of the typed questions and answers to Miss Bullis and Mrs. Matsu.
- You will submit the questions and answers to www.turnitin.com by 8:30am, Monday 12/15 for Mr. Swenson.

We will use the following rubric when grading your project:

Questions/Answers – 80 points total

Level 1 – 30 points (2 points each)

Level 2 – 20 points (4 points each)

Level 3 – 30 points (6 points each)

Creativity – 10 points total

Time & effort – 5 points

Overall design – 5 points

Playability – 10 points total

Rules of game/logic – 10 points
